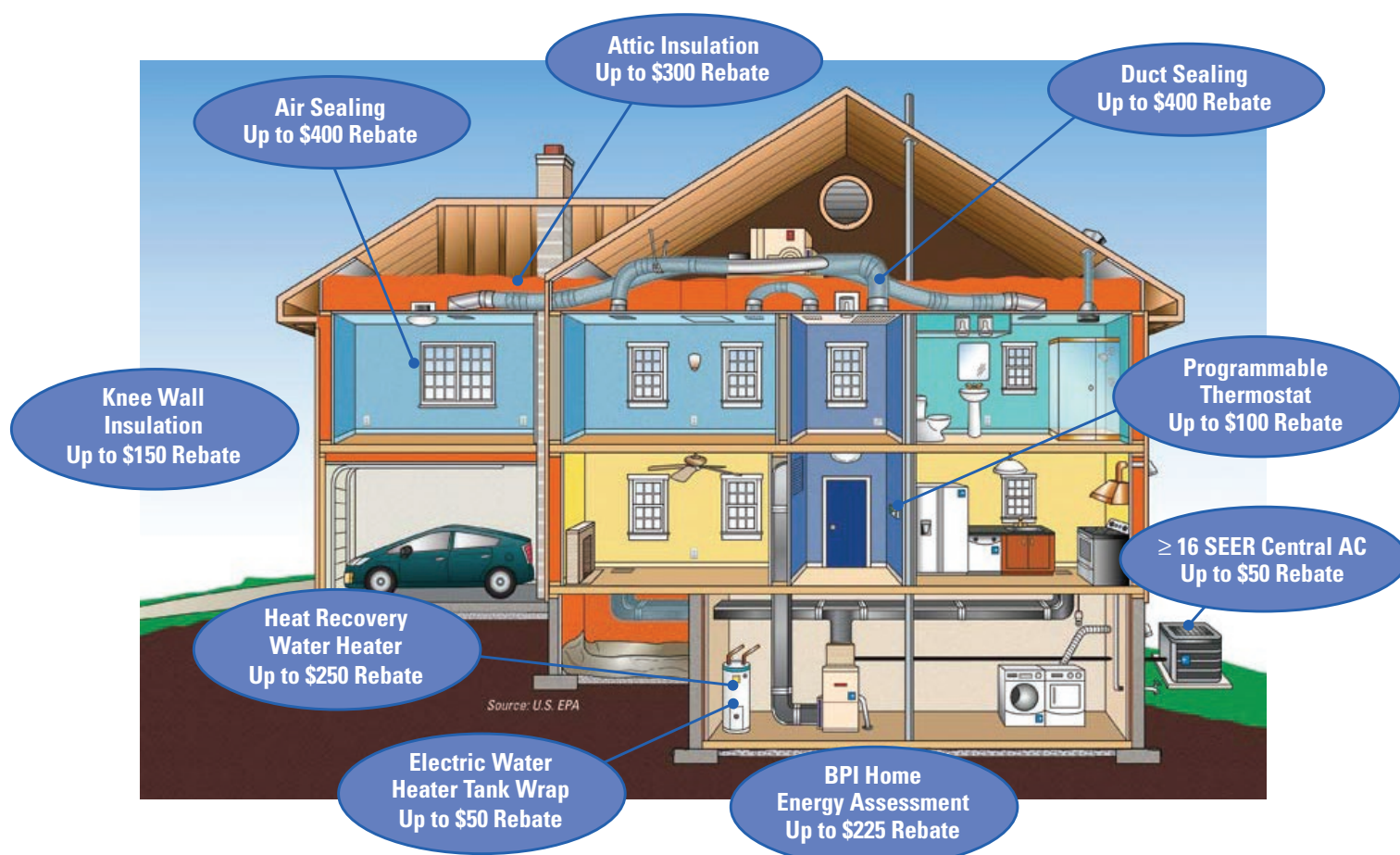

Information on Individual Improvements Approach

Are you looking for a way to save money, make your home more energy efficient and be comfortable in every room of your house? If so, Georgia Power's Home Energy Improvement Program can help.

The benefits of the Individual Improvements approach include:

- Total rebates up to \$700 per year (up to 50 percent of installed cost)
- Flexible improvement options for your budget
- Work performed by a participating BPI contractor, certified contractor or homeowner (depending on improvement type)
- More comfortable rooms with fewer drafts and hot/cold spots
- Annual electric energy use savings

Within 60 days of your home energy improvement materials purchase date and/or equipment installation date, you must apply for your rebates by submitting the proper documentation outlined on the application on our website. If you are using a participating contractor, please identify up front who will be submitting the rebate application. Please allow for 6-8 weeks for your rebate to arrive by mail.

Information on Whole House Approach

Do you know how much energy your home is wasting?

Small energy leaks can really add up. The average home has enough air leaks to create an opening over 3 feet wide. Schedule a Whole House Energy Assessment, performed by a certified BPI contractor, to find out where your home is losing energy.

The benefits of the Whole House approach include:

- Rebates up to \$2,575 to help cover a portion of the Building Performance Institute (BPI) Assessment and improvement costs
- Potential annual electric savings of up to 30 percent
- Work performed by a Georgia Power program-participating contractor
- Third-party quality assurance to verify that the work is done properly
- More comfortable rooms with fewer drafts and hot/cold spots

3 Easy Steps to Get You Started:

- 1 ASSESS**
A BPI Assessment is performed, and customized recommendations will be suggested.
- 2 IMPROVE**
Select recommended improvements to make.
- 3 VERIFY**
A follow-up BPI Assessment is performed to measure the total electric reduction goal (20 percent to 30 percent) and determine qualifying rebates.

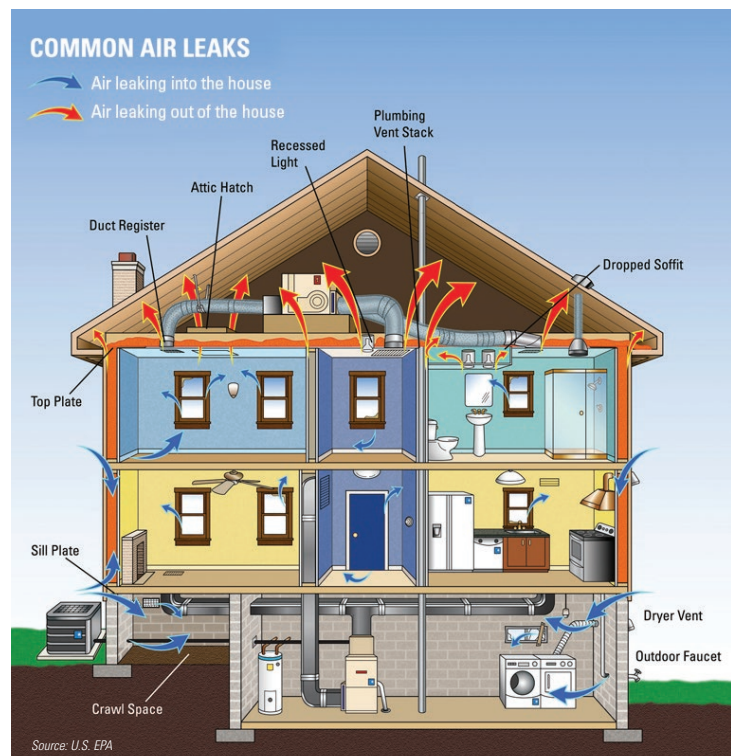

50% up to \$1,700
